## 3. SYNOPSIS

I see a tree and I say: "this is a tree". Then I probably say: "this is a big willow tree". Then I name it my shelter and I lie under it to enjoy the coolness of its shadow. The wind on its leaves blows away the shapes and the colours. It is not a tree anymore.

Apparently, we label everything. It is in our human nature. First we label and then we look to understand and connect. The more we connect, the more we un-label. The big "L" Love is a state in which labels and boundaries have faded away.

100 Artists from all over Europe 3 International workshops

1 Theme: LOVE

This resulted in the Un-Label interdisciplinary company of 16 international artists who through theatre, dance, music, poetry, aerials and media, seek to understand and express the question – Do I need Labels to Love?

Each performance is accessible through audio and text description for visually impaired and deaf audience.

## 4. ASSEMBLY

#### **CHARACTERISTICS AND NEEDS**

Assembly Time: 2,5 Days + 1 Show Day

Disassembly Time: 3 Hours

Dimensions scenic space: 12m wide x 12m deep (Minimum: 10m wide x 10m deep)

Height: Minimum 6m, side stage preferred to be open

Constraints of space: Black dance floor

Assembly needs: Rigging-3 fixed rigging points (1 at the back right corner, 2 at



the left middle part of stage). Fixing point for rope rigging at left side stage. **Caution: Rigging points** used for performance activities, **must take at least 200 kg dynamic.** 

## **STAGE DESIGN**

- 1 ramp/big table, (4 x 1 m, hight 0,8m) has to be built or brought by company
- Vertical cloth (at the right back corner) will be brought by company
- Vertical rope (2 points at the left middle part of stage) will be brought by company
- Hazer (if available)


