Artistic Vision

We challenge established concepts of body, space, and society, which allows us to push beyond the conventional criteria of contemporary culture. In doing so, we venture into territory unknown even to us. Encountering the unfamiliar, otherness, and the unknown is the creative driving force behind Un-Label.

Interdisciplinary

Theatre as a hyper medium: Un-Label considers the equal synergy of different art forms essential for stage work. That includes music, dance, theatre, acrobatics, video and poetry. Each element may take the leading role in shaping either a single image or the big picture. The multiple layers of the stories told define the expressive choices.

Inclusive

Differences are an integral and essential part of progressive artistic processes. Inclusion allows us to take a closer and more conscious look at our differences and commonalities. We think and practise accessibility as aesthetic vocabulary, which helps us expand our artistic expression and increase our social understanding.

Reducing barriers

Our varied projects have a common aim: To develop innovative and inclusive opportunities for the performing arts — across countries and borders. We bring together artists with and without disabilities from all over Europe. Together they explore the enormous potential of an inclusive and interdisciplinary artistic practice. This reduces barriers, particularly in our minds, and allows equal participation in art and culture for everybody. The performances we develop in our projects unveil the vast artistic potential of the participants to a wide audience.

Overcoming boundaries

Our pilot project **Verflüchtigung** was the first theatre project at a European level that was inclusive as well as international and interdisciplinary.

This approach was further developed in our project Un-Label — New grounds for inclusive performing arts. We have succeeded in building a dynamic European network of artists and organisations that strive to develop and implement new methods for the inclusive performing arts.

With ImPArt we take accessibility a step further by regarding it as an impulse for innovation in the artistic process. Auxiliary means enrich the work of art through their own aesthetic possibilities. We make them part of the performance and thus turn them into art themselves.

The project **Creability** deals with the following question: How can we reshape creative methods to make them applicable to all human beings?





Performances

Ambitious and accessible

Our ensembles consist of international artists with and without disabilities. They use their varied types of artistic expression, which include music, dance, theatre, acrobatics, video, and poetry, to create performances that are both complex and accessible. Our work turns accessibility into a source of inspiration, experiment, and artistic creation. Auxiliary means such as captions and sign language are part of the performances and thus become art themselves.


Inspiring diversity

We are continuously developing new, innovative performances. For example Verflüchtigung - Can there be identity without otherness?, where we are looking into the nature of identity and the meaning of otherness. The performance is an allegorical reflection on social values that finds fun ways to reveal the absurdity of our prejudices and preformed opinions. Or we go looking for love with L - Do I need Labels to Love? The performance takes the audience on an emotional journey that leads them to themselves and one another. With **PRESENT** we explore the tension between our self-image and how others see us, between illusion and reality, and between the past and our responsibility for what will be history in the future.
